II. What it is.

The Lord's Supper is the privilege and right of every believer to remember Christ's suffering & death on the cross. We do this by eating a wafer representing Christ's body, drinking juice representing his blood, along with prayer and worship. The wafer symbolizes his physical suffering which gives us physical healing (*Isaiah 53:5*), and the juice symbolizes his blood which gives us forgiveness and justification (*Hebrews 9:22*).
